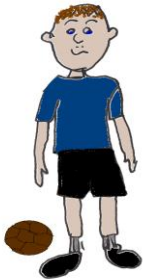


An Educational Psychologist Comes to Our School



What is an Educational Psychologist (EP)?

An EP wants children to be happy
and learn in school.



They talk to children, teachers, mums and dads and
other adults about school.



Why does an EP want to talk to me?

Your teacher has asked them for some help.



An EP talks to lots of children in different schools and helps lots of teachers.

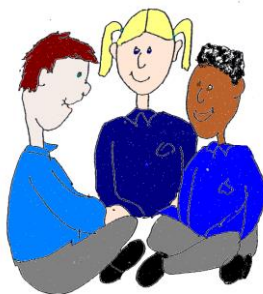
The EP will ask you if you would like to talk to them.

Sometimes they may visit you at home.

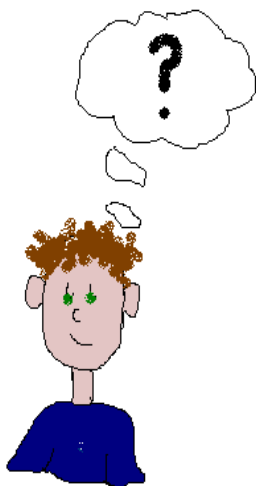
What will happen when I see an EP?

They may ask you about things you are good at.

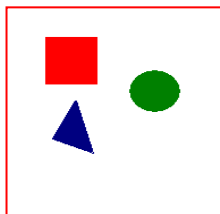
They may ask you about things you want to get better at.
